

ISLAM – MUSLIM RENUNCIATION PRAYER

Declaration

Dear Heavenly Father, I believe that Jesus Christ of Nazareth was born from the seed of a woman (**Gen 3:15**), that He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born from the **virgin Mary**. He is **Immanuel** - God with us (**Matt 1:20, Is 7:14**).

I believe that God established his Covenant with Isaac, Abraham's legitimate son, and not with Ishmael, the son of his bondswoman, it being an everlasting Covenant (**Gal 3:16, Gen 17:1a**). I believe that a Child (Jesus Christ) was born unto us; the rulership is upon His shoulders and His Name is Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, and Prince of Peace (**Is 9:5**).

I believe that the Messiah, **Jesus Christ of Nazareth**, was born from the **Tribe of Judah**; that He has been appointed as Ruler even before the beginning of time, from everlasting (**Micah 5:1, Heb 7:14**).

I believe that Jesus Christ came from the stem of Jesse. He is the one upon whom the Spirit of the Lord rests; the Spirit of Wisdom and Understanding, the Spirit of Counsel and Might, and the Spirit of Knowledge and of the Fear of God (**Is 11:1,2**).

I believe that Jesus Christ is the **Only Begotten Son of God** and that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have everlasting life (**John 3:16, 1 John 4:10**). Jesus Christ of Nazareth is the **Only Way**, the whole **Truth**, and the **eternal Life**, and **no one** can come to the Father except **through Him** (**John 14:6**).

I believe that Jesus Christ died for **my sins** on the **cross of Golgotha** and that **nobody else** died in His place on the cross of Golgotha. **He** was wounded for my transgressions and bruised for my iniquities, our chastisement was upon Him and He carried it on the cross of Golgotha so that by **His stripes** we can be healed (**Is 53:5**).

I believe that I have an advocate with the Father, that is Jesus Christ, the Righteous One, who is the only propitiation for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the whole world (**1 John 2:1,2**). The **Blood of Jesus Christ, the Son of God**, cleanses me from all sin (**1 John 1:7**).

I believe that the **Bible** is the **only** inspired Word of God given for doctrine, for reproof, for correction and instruction in righteousness (**2 Tim 3:14-16**). The Word of God shall never pass away or be replaced by any other book or word; The Word of God will stand forever, even though earth and heaven shall pass away (**Matt 5:18; Matt 24:35; Is 40:8; 2 Tim 3:16**).

I believe that the Word of God was inspired by the Holy Spirit and not by the angel Gabriel (**1 Pet 1:25; 2 Pet 1:21**).

I declare that the Gabriel who appeared to Mohammed was a counterfeit of Satan. I believe in the Triune God and baptism in the Name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit (**Matt 28:19**). God gave us His Holy Spirit (parakletos) - Greek, the Comforter - and not "paracletas" (Arabic) meaning "Mahmood". The Word of God is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

I believe that God sent us His Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Truth, and not Mohammed (**1 Thess 4:8**). We have the Spirit of Jesus Christ as our helper. God sent forth the Spirit of His Son - "Ibn Allah", Arabic for Son of God - and not "Walad Allah", meaning Child of God, because Jesus was conceived by the Holy Spirit - not by physical intercourse between God and Mary (**Gal 4:6**).

I believe that the Blood of Jesus has cleansed me from all my sin; that I am justified in the Name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God (**1 Cor. 6:11**). I believe that the Blood of Jesus Christ, who through the Eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot or blemish to God, have cleansed my conscience from dead works so that I can now serve the Living God (**Heb 9:14**).

I believe that Judas Iscariot betrayed Jesus Christ for thirty pieces of silver. Afterward, he committed suicide by hanging himself. He did not die in the place of Jesus Christ on the cross of Golgotha. (**Matt 27:5; Acts 1:18,19**.) I believe that Jesus Christ Himself died on the cross and no substitute at all was crucified in place of Him.

I believe that the four Gospels according to Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John do not represent four separate Bibles, but rather the eyewitness accounts of the same events experienced by four different people. "*By the mouth of two or three witnesses every word shall be established.*" (**2 Cor. 13:1**).

Renunciation Prayer

Father, I come to You in the Name of **Your Son, Jesus Christ** and I repent of having believed Islam to be the only true religion. I ask Your forgiveness for having believed these lies and ask You to sever me from any **spirits of false doctrine and deception**. Thank You that I am now free by Your Spirit of Truth.

In the Name of Jesus, I repent and renounce the following teachings of the Muslims (Islam):

1. That Christianity is a false religion.
2. That Islam came into being because of the corruption of Christianity, being the reason why Christianity can never be accepted since that would denounce the very reason for the existence of Islam.
1. That followers of Islam being converted to Christianity are traitors deserving the punishment of death.
3. That all Christians are blasphemers and have been deceived.
4. That the Koran is superior to the Bible.
5. That the Bible has been altered by translations and is therefore no longer reliable as being the True Word of God. That God had to send another True Word, the Koran, to replace the unreliable Bible.

[**Counselors:**

The Koran itself does not state that the Bible has been altered. On the contrary, it states that a person who do not obey the Torah and the Bible amounts to nothing. In the Koran, there are several references to the Torah, Zabur (OT) and Psalms, and the Injil (NT). At the time of the Koran's first being written, there was no question of the Bible's having been altered and the Bible was accepted as true. The deception came later. The Bible had already existed on clay tablets and parchment scrolls for more than 1400 years before Islam! Old transcripts of the Bible can be found in the London Museum and the Vatican in Rome.] Final prophet of God. That Jesus Christ was only one of many other prophets.

8. That the prophet Mohammed was the greatest and true and final prophet of God. That Jesus Christ was only one of many other prophets.

9a. That God established only three religions on earth, i.e. Judaism, Christianity, and Islam.

9b. That God sent Moses to establish Judaism, but because of the disobedience of the Jews, God punished them by scattering them over the face of the earth.

9c. That God then sent Jesus Christ to establish Christianity. However, by the fifth century, Christianity was so corrupt, that God sent Mohammed to establish Islam. That was the final revelation of God. Islam incorporates both Judaism and Christianity, thus being the only true religion.

Father, in the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, Your Son, I declare that Your purpose was never to establish a religion, but to work reconciliation and create a personal relationship between man and Yourself (**Rom 3:25; 5:11; 1 John 2:2; 4:10**).

10. That Jesus Christ is not the only Way to the Father. I confess that Jesus Christ of Nazareth **is** the only "Seed" who crushed the head of the serpent.

I confess that all the prophecies of the prophets refer only to One Messiah, that is Jesus Christ the Son of God, and not to Mohammed or anyone else (**Is 7:14; Is 9:6; Matt 1:23**). I confess Jesus Christ to be the Only Way to You (**John 14:6**).

11. That Jesus Christ is not the Son of God; God cannot have a physical son, without having had sex with Mary.

I confess that Jesus Christ was born of the Virgin Mary by the working of God's Holy Spirit. Jesus is the Spiritual Son of God, as well as being the Word that became flesh and dwelt among us (**John 1: 1,10,14**). According to the Word of God, which I confess to be the truth, I declare anyone who does not confess Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh, to be a deceiver and the anti-Christ (**2 John 1:7**). Whoever does not believe this, does not have God, but he who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son (**2 John 1:9**).

12. That the prophet Mohammed was the greatest and true and final prophet of God. That Jesus Christ was only one of many other prophets.

I confess my faith in the Triune God, i e God the Father, God the So and God the Holy Spirit, being One. I believe that no one speaking by the Spirit of God can call Jesus accursed, and no

one can say that Jesus is Lord except by the Holy Spirit (**1 Cor 12:3**). I believe that God was manifested in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen by angels, preached among the gentiles, believed on in the world and received up in glory (**1 Tim 3:16**).

14. That Abraham had to sacrifice Ishmael instead of Isaac (**Gen 22:2,9** proves the contrary).

15. There is only one purpose which is to unite the world through Islam.

I confess that only One Kingdom shall fill the whole earth, being the Kingdom of the Triune God. God himself will set up this Kingdom that shall never be destroyed nor be left to **other people** (or to Islam); it shall consume and break to pieces all other kingdoms and shall stand forever (**Dan 2:44**).

16. That Mecca is a Holy City, declared by Mohammed. I confess that the Word of God mentions only one Holy City, the Holy City of Jerusalem. I, therefore, renounce any reference to Mecca being a Holy City. (**Rev 21:10-24**.)

17. That the KA'ABA containing the black stone is a Holy Place, the black stone within it being a Holy Altar to Allah.

I repent and renounce this man-made shrine, as well as the stone, and declare that God does not inhabit any temple made by man. There is no resemblance between the Temple of God and the Temple of idols because we ourselves are the Temple of God. (**2 Cor 6:16; Acts 7:49**.)

[Counselors:

For many, many centuries this "shrine" of Ka'aba has been a pagan place of idol worship where sacrifices were made on the black stone. The only difference is that Allah has now become the idol!] I now renounce the Muslim credo, turn my back on it and walk away from any ungodly, false altar and doctrine.

18. The lie that women have no rights (Islam). (Women must wear veils and may not attend services in the mosque, because men are superior.) I also renounce the following doctrines of Islam, i e:

1. The SHARI'A (Law of Islam), forming the foundation of Islam, as well as the four pillars, i e:

- a. The KORAN.
- b. The SUNNA - example of the prophet Mohammed.
- c. Corresponding (analogous) "QIYAS" - meaning the development of a new law by means of the Koran and the Sunna.
- d. IJMA - reaching consensus with the help of interpretation (ijtihad) by professionals (Uluma).

2. Prescribed rules and regulations regarding a Muslim's way of life - that which is compulsory and should be emphasized, and that which is forbidden. I renounce any blood sacrifice in which.

I have partaken or carried out, and sever by the Blood of Jesus any curses, or bondages established in the spiritual realm by these rituals.

3. That there is no distinction between the personal and the communal, the religious and the worldly, the sacred and the sacrilegious, and between the spiritual and the material, everything being one and the same. I renounce Jihad, the Holy War - which is an honor to kill or be killed for Allah.

I confess that according to the Word of God, we are to deny our worldly lusts and not to love the world; that friendship with the world is enmity with God (**James 4:4; Titus 2:12; 1 John 2:15**). I confess that God commands us to be holy as He is holy. He will come to make a judgment on all, to convict all the ungodly of their ungodly deeds and of all the harsh things (blasphemy) they have spoken against Him (**Jude 1:15**).

4. that the Koran is the infallible Word of God which has never been altered, every word being the truth as revealed to Mohammed by the angel Gabriel.

I confess that the Bible, i e the Word of God, is inspired by God Himself and not by an angel. God cannot lie, and because He does not change, His Word also remains unchangeable. (**Num 23:19; 2 Pet 1:20,21**.)

In the Name of **Jesus Christ of Nazareth** I renounce the Koran as being the Word of God. I turn my back on it, take back what is mine, and tear up any contract with Satan or with Islam.

5. That the repetition of passages from the Koran brings grace even though you do not understand the words.

I declare that the repetition of words cannot bring grace, since the law came through Moses, but the Grace and the Truth came through Jesus Christ (**John 1:17**). I believe that I have been saved only by the Grace of Jesus Christ and not because of my own works or vain repetition of words (**Acts 15:11**).

I repent and renounce the "Hadith", the record of Mohammed's life and the standards, which he had set for every Muslim.

I confess that the Word of God is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path (**Ps 119:105**). I choose to cleanse my way by heeding unto the Word of God (**Ps 119:9**). I will never forget Your precepts, for by them You have given me life (**Ps 119:93**).

I repent and renounce the "Sunna" - the example set by the prophet Mohammed according to which every Muslim must live. I ask forgiveness for being involved in these books and now turn my back on them. I declare that from now on the Bible and Jesus Christ of Nazareth shall be my Only Guide.

I repent and renounce the 99 names of the Muslim God which have to be repeated over and over again, as well as the rosary used for this purpose (a name for every bead).

I admit that I cannot be saved by the mere repetition of the names of their god, but only through the Blood of Jesus Christ of Nazareth by which He has paid the price on the cross of Golgotha.

In the Name of **Jesus Christ of Nazareth**, I now sever my family and myself from every group of Islam, i.e. the "Sunni" and the "Shi'ite". I cut any soul tie with any teacher, any "Imam", Mohammed, and any Guru, in the Name of Jesus. I claim back what is mine and tear up any contracts with Satan, in the Name of Jesus. I renounce the three groupings within the "Shi'ite", i.e. "Zaidis", "12 Imam" and "7 Imam", as well as the Aga Khan is one of the Imams.

I reject and renounce all Muslim Holy Days along with their bondages and rituals and declare myself cleansed in the Blood of my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ of Nazareth:

1. RAMADAAN - 31 December 1997
2. EID-UL-FITR - 30 January 1998
3. HADJ - 6 April 1998
4. EID-UL-ADHA - 7 April 1998
5. MUHARRAM - 28 April 1998
6. AA'SHURAH - 7 May 1998
7. BIRTH OF PROPHET MOHAMMED - 6 July
8. LAITATUL ME'RAJ (EVE) - 17 November
9. LAITATUL BARA'AT (EVE) - 5 December
10. COMMENCEMENT OF RAMADAAN - 20 December.

(NB: All these dates are subject to the sighting of the moon and are therefore inconclusive.)
I repent and renounce the Cave of Hira and the Mountain of Light where Mohammed received his so-called revelations from the angel Gabriel.

In the Name of Jesus, I sever my family and myself from these false revelations.

I sever myself from the false Islamic Calendar and the day of "Lailatul - Qadr" (the day on which Mohammed received the revelation).

I reject and renounce the belief that the moon is a manifestation of Allah.

I renounce the halaal and haraam (signs on food indicating whether it is prohibited or not).

I confess that according to the Word of God we cannot be commended to God because of what we eat or drink (**1 Cor. 8:8**), only by doing the Will of God.

I confess that what goes into a man's mouth does not make him "unclean", but that which comes out of his mouth is what makes him unclean (**Matt 15:11**).

I renounce the following Islam gods:

- Azan
- Allah

- Mohammed
- Jinn
- Zanzibar
- Tokoloshe
- Poltergeist
- Mind control / Meditations
- Sacrifice of animals
- Moram
- Badsha Peer

Thank You, Father, that I can now once and for all renounce everything related to Islam. In the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, I now take back what is mine and tear up every contract with Satan or Islam. I confess Jesus Christ to be Lord of my life and that I have received redemption from my sin by His coming in the flesh, His Blood, and His victory on the cross of Golgotha. AMEN.
