

## Cursed Objects

Objects that are purchased or given as gifts can sometimes be problematic and carry curses or hexes that provide demons' entry into your home. Be particularly careful when purchasing or receiving as a gift any of the following:

1. Tribal items: These may be from a Native American, African, Mayan, Aztecan, Filipino, Haitian, or other cultural setting. It may involve a piece of artwork, jewelry, mask, or other objects. Many souvenir items may seem harmless when purchased but carry the occultic power of the culture with them. Make sure that you hear from the Holy Spirit regarding any item that you purchase. Especially if it comes from India. Everything in India is dedicated to a god. Do the following:
  - A. Pray over it
  - B. Breaking all curses and hexes, and
  - C. Pronounce a blessing over it before bringing it to your home.

If you receive an item as a gift, ask the Holy Spirit whether you may keep it, and if so, what you need to do regarding the object to cleanse it.

2. Antique Items: Family heirlooms that have been handed down from generation to generation, or items purchased privately or via an auction may have residual demonic spirits from past owners. Make sure that you pray over each item when it is handed down from a family member or family member, consider the ownership of the item as you pray over it. When purchasing an item, ask the following questions:
  - a. Receive as much information that would be helpful to your decision-making as possible.
  - b. Again, allow the Holy Spirit to guide your purchase.

Collectibles also fall into this category. Especially when dealing with antiquities, military items, and various swords, daggers, and other items used in warfare, break off any spirits of murder that might be attached to these items.

Father God, in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, I take this object and I break every demonic spirit that may be attached to it. I command every demonic spirit to go to the feet of Jesus and never return.

In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, I dedicate this object to the Lord God to bless it and reverse all curses of the object and ask you to anoint it in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth.
